

KORF Grant Eligibility



Research proposals may be individual researcher's projects or part of a larger research project related to ovarian cancer. All research proposals will be considered, however special consideration may be given to collaborative projects. Consideration will be given to proposals aimed to research early detection, better treatment, or a cure for ovarian cancer.

Grant proposals for 2024 will initially be for \$50,000, but may exceed that amount.

SELECTION

Proposals will be reviewed by KORF's Director and Board. Award recipients will be announced by late June 2024.

TIMELINE

Grant Submissions are due on May 1, 2024. Notifications will be made by the Katie Oppo Research Fund (KORF) within 60 days of receipt of the proposal.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Proposals must include the following:

Abstract of proposed research

Describe the rationale of the study, its goals, and an overview of research design and methods, name and contact information of head researcher (name, title, email address, institution) and who will be working on the project.

Lay summary of proposed research

Describe the goals, means, and methods of the proposed research in terms an educated lay person would understand and describe the significance of the research to the patient population (one page or less).

Research Proposal

Include any supporting information deemed essential including preliminary data (if applicable) as well as the details outlined below (not to exceed 5 pages- not including references).

Budget/Funds/Grant:

Full details and itemization of direct cost expenditures the grant is to be used for. Details regarding salary and labs costs.

The following KORF financial statement must be included in the proposal: "Should funds be granted to you as a researcher, they may not go through your institution's 'Development Office,' or go directly to the general coffers of your research institution but said funds must be solely allocated at the discretion of the researcher named at the institution to be distributed in the manner agreed upon by KORF. These funds may follow the research to another institution."

Project Timeline:

Detail the expected chronological progress of research goals. Send bi-annual updates to KORF.
